Group Reservation Policies

Reservation

- Reservations must be made at least 48 hours in advance. All reservations are first-come, first serve and subject to availability.
- Group rate reservations are available Monday - Friday 10 am - 3 pm only. Discounts are not available after 4 pm on weekdays or weekends.
- Tickets are available in hourly increments starting on each hour. Must be consecutive hours. Your group is welcome to leave/re-enter park at any time between your reservation time for lunch, bathroom, activity or etc. breaks.
- A minimum of 12 tickets must be purchased to qualify for group rate; estimated numbers may be adjusted on day of visit; please do your best to notify us before arrival should your estimated numbers fluctuate more than 20 guests.
- Smaller groups may be booked with another smaller group. Additionally, our facility is always welcome to the public, the park is not closed for your group.
- We suggest larger groups separate into sessions (i.e. For groups visiting for 2 hours: one-half of the group goes each hour while the other hour they may eat lunch, play volleyball or other activities that may have been brought.)
- Payment is due in full upon arrival. Pre-payments are accepted via credit card or check. Any overpayments will be credited towards a future visit or mailed a check for the returnable balance. We accept MasterCard, Visa, Cash, or Check.
- Your reservation will be held temporarily until this form has been received with a \$50 deposit per visit.
- Please do not include chaperones in group totals, only tickets that you will be paying for (chaperones not using water do not have to purchase tickets). Chaperones & group leaders are expected to supervise groups at all areas of the facility including in restrooms and on slides.
- Use of group tickets constitutes acceptance of Yawgoo Valley Water Park Policies.

Cancellations / Refunds / Inclement Weather

- **Deposit Refund Policy:** If your group cancels more than 24 hours your deposit will be returned in full OR can be applied to a future visit. Cancellations after 3pm the day prior to your visit OR no shows will forfeit deposit.
- **Inclement Weather:** In the event of closing due to inclement weather; we will contact you 24 hours in advance of your visit to offer a rebooking. In most cases, we remain open in the rain, barring thunder/lightning. If only rain is forecasted it is your responsibility to contact us regarding cancellations. Park Rules

Dress Code

- Only swimming attire is allowed on the waterslides. Cut - off jeans, shorts, tee or regular shorts and extra clothing of any kind are **NOT** allowed on slides or in the pools. In case of sun sensitivity, a tee shirt may be worn. Swim attire with rivets, buckles or exposed metal is not permitted. Keep in mind: different material swimwear will affect the speed of sliding.
- We are a family-friendly facility. Obscene attire is prohibited including revealing/inappropriate or graphic clothing.

Conduct / Behavior

- Chaperones/group leaders are responsible for all members of their group. Please review park rules with your group prior to/upon arrival. Participants misbehaving may be asked to "sit out" of the pool area temporarily or permanently at the discretion of lifeguards. Children must be accompanied by a chaperone/counselor to the indoor facilities. Chaperones may be assigned locations within the pool/slide area, to help maintain group safety by the lifeguards on duty. Group leaders & chaperones are responsible for their group in and out of the pool area. The park and facilities close at 5pm, groups are expected to leave premise at that time.
- Guests are always expected to follow staff instructions ; including chaperones and group leaders. No Lifeguard on duty. No Diving, No Running, No Head first or spinning in slides, no animals or pets, no food, drink or glass in pool area, no one under 18 permitted unless accompanied by an adult. No coolers allowed in tiki bar area, no disposable diapers in water park, no alcohol, no barbeque grills, or pop-up tents. Use of slides is suggested for guests under 175lbs.

Food & Beverage

- Outside food and non-alcoholic beverages (picnics/coolers) are allowed only the picnic areas.
- There are absolutely no food or drinks permitted in tiki bar & water park areas except water (non-glass containers).
- Grills & alcohol brought from home is not permitted. Groups will not be permitted to consume alcohol.
- The tiki snack bar is open daily; options including cheeseburgers, hot dogs, chicken tenders, fries, ice cream and more!
- Absolutely no food or drink (other than bottled water in a non-glass container) are permitted inside the water park gates.
- We cannot store food or drinks in our (this includes refrigerator & freezer storage).

Arrival/Check-In

- Arrive Early. We cannot extend your time should you arrive late. The grounds and facility is open to the public at 9:30am until 5:30pm
- One designated group representative should report to the tiki bar 15+ minutes before start of reservation time. Final group count & payment should be provided at this time.
- A lifeguard will either board group buses or assemble your group in the picnic areas to provide park rules. We require all "non-swimmers" be designated by a wristband, we will provide.
